

SKI TRIPS

RSAC's Ski Season is shaping up beautifully with offerings at three of the Club's favorite destinations. Stay Tuned, within the week we will have a few final travel details confirmed, and the trips will be published.

Check out our Best of the Best out West!

Big Sky, Montana February 8th - 15th

Stay at the iconic Huntley Lodge (newly remodeled) and enjoy their wonderful breakfast buffet included in your trip package. Big Sky Resort offers over 5,850 acres of skiable terrain, servicing 4,350 feet of vertical via 24 chair lifts and 12 surface lifts. The ski area has a summit elevation of 11,166 feet and sees an average annual snowfall of more than 400 inches. The resort has been lauded for its incredible vertical drop and also the very minimal wait times due to its advanced lift system. Big Sky resort is the basecamp to Yellowstone National Park and provides daily shuttles to Yellowstone's west entrance. Plan a very special Day Trip on a snowmobile or a snowcat tour through Yellowstone's winter wonderland, a magical experience.

Snowmass/Aspen, Colorado February 22nd - March 1st

The luxury ski-in/ski-out ski Top of the Village Condos in Snowmass Village are the perfect home base for your week at Aspen/Snowmass. With four distinct mountains that offer some of the best skiing in the world it's easy to see why this is always a club favorite destination. Aspen Mountain is considered the "town mountain," known for its long groomers and steep gladed terrain. Buttermilk is great for beginners and families (and known for hosting the Winter X Games). Snowmass is our favorite with its groomers, trees, 3,500 acres of skiable terrain, and 4,406 feet of vertical. But, don't overlook Aspen Highlands with 4,352 feet of vertical and 1,500 acres of skiable terrain. All four mountains in one week!

Steamboat, Colorado March 1st – 7th

We have a perfect location in Steamboat Village at Gravity Haus Hotel, conveniently situated at the base of the Steamboat Gondola. Steamboat Ski Resort is a premier ski destination famous for its Champagne Powder. The mountain is also known for its unique aspen glades, offering up some of the best tree skiing in North America. Founded in 1963, Steamboat Ski Resort is situated across seven mountain peaks within the Park Range and overlooks the Yampa Valley. The area has a rich western heritage and cowboy vibe. Steamboat Springs has been dubbed Ski Town, U.S.A. ®, due to the fact that more Olympians call Steamboat home than any other ski resort. The resort has over 2,965 acres of skiable terrain, 169 named trails, and 18 lifts. The base elevation is 6,900 feet, and the summit elevation is 10,568 feet. The vertical rise is 3,668 feet.


